Saint Faustina - The Apostle of Divine Mercy

St. Faustina (Helen Kowalska), born on August 25, 1905 in the village of Głogowiec, near Łeczyca, was the third of ten children, of Stanisław and Marianna Kowalski. Raised in a simple but deep faith, she has become an important instrument in God's hands for the conversion of the contemporary world. She is called the Apostle of Divine Mercy. It was she who, although she did not even graduate from elementary school, was chosen by Jesus to remind the world of the truth about God's infinite Mercy: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy." (Diarv #699). Extremely modest and humble, she received the grace of meeting Jesus and talking to him. Jesus, however, gave her the difficult task of telling mankind about the salvation that can only be found in God who is rich in mercy. "No soul will be justified until it turns with confidence to My mercy," (Diary #570). It is thanks to her trust in God that the truth concerning our salvation in God, was given greater focus. Faustina, not without obstacles, but consistently obeying her confessor and through him Jesus, commissioned the image of the Merciful Jesus with the slogan: JESUS I TRUST IN YOU and the transmission of a special praver: THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY. Her spiritual notes written in several notebooks were compiled into what is called THE DIARY OF SAINT FAUSTINA KOWALSKA (Divine Mercy in my soul), which is among the great classics of spiritual literature.

In our church, on the right side of the altar, there is a painting of St. Faustina, which is venerated by many of the faithful who visit. We are also fortunate to have a relic of her, which is generally available for veneration on the 1st Sunday of each month, after the 4pm English Mass (refer to "Pastoral Announcements" for more details).

NOTEBOOK II, 718

After Holy Communion, I heard these words:— You see what you are of yourself, but do not be frightened at this. If I were to reveal to you the whole misery that you are, you would die of terror. However, be aware of what you are. Because you are such great misery, I have revealed to you the whole ocean of My mercy. I seek and desire souls like yours, but they are few. Your great trust in Me forces Me to continuously grant you graces. You have great and incomprehensible rights over My Heart, for you are a daughter of complete trust. You would not have been able to bear the magnitude of the love which I have for you if I had revealed it to you fully here on earth. I often give you a glimpse of it, but know that this is only an exceptional grace from Me. My love and mercy knows no bounds.

NOTEBOOK II, 719

(150) Today, I heard these words: Know, my child, that for your sake I grant blessings to this whole vicinity. But you ought to thank Me on their behalf, as they do not thank Me for the kindnesses I extend to them. For the sake of your gratitude, I will continue to bless them.

"At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for poor sinners: and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into My mortal sorrow. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion..." (Diary, 1320)

Pastoral Announcements
